Renew your 2025 Migratory Bird Permit today!

Now is the perfect time to have Hawkeye.ca assist with applying for or renewing your 2025 Migratory Bird Damage or Danger Permit under the Migratory Birds Regulations, 2022 Act. (sor/2022-105).

If you need to manage nuisance migratory birds during their nesting season, contact Hawkeye.ca at +1 (416) 429-5393 to secure your 2025 permit. Nesting periods typically begin in the last week of March and end in the final week of August.

To legally engage in any activities involving prohibited actions under the Act, a permit is mandatory. Permits are issued by the Canadian Wildlife Service (CWS), a branch of the Department of Environment and Climate Change Canada..







AVOID DEVASTATING PROPERTY DAMAGE

ROOF DAMAGE:

Nesting birds with their continuous toxic droppings can shorten the lifespan of a warehouse roof by half. We have even seen total roof collapses caused by these pests. When drainage systems are blocked by nests and water is allowed to rise as little as six inches, the damage can be catastrophic.

DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT & STRUCTURES:

Acidic bird droppings can destroy air conditioning and industrial machinery, siding, insulation, water towers, roof equipment, etc.

VENTILATION & FIRE HAZARDS:

Nests can also block ventilation systems. This has caused human deaths by carbon monoxide poisoning. Plus, nests near electric signs or machinery are a great fire risk.
